MANCHESTER HOLDS OFF ADRIAN IN 80-79 WIN

The Spartan men's basketball team held off a late run by Adrian to post an 80-79 win over the Bulldogs on Saturday. Manchester led by 10 points, 68-58, with four and a half minutes remaining, but Adrian cut the lead to four points with two minutes remaining. The Spartans hit eight of ten free throws down the stretch to hold on to the one point win.

Manchester shot 53% from the floor for the game, and hit 46% of their three point attempts, including 7-13 tries in the first half.

Jeff Grabowski led Manchester with 20 points. He was 9-10 from the floor and added two rebounds and a steal. Jamaal Wade added 17 points and eight rebounds, with five assists and two steals. Wes Gardner added 16 points, four steals and three rebounds, while James Reed hit 4-6 shots from the floor for 10 points.

Manchester moves to 9-3 on the year, and returns to action January 3, as they travel to Hanover to resume HCAC conference action.

MANCHESTER FALLS IN CONSOLATION GAME AT TRINITY TOURNAMENT

The Manchester College women's basketball team fell in the consolation game of the Trinity University Holiday Tournament to Bethel College 66-57. Manchester led by two points at the half, 29-27, and led by three points, 56-53, with 3:30 remaining in the game. Bethel went on a 13-1 run to close out the game and pick up the win. Bethel hit all 19 free throw attempts in the second half.

The Spartans were led by Sarah Bose's 15 points. She added seven rebounds, seven steals and six assists. Heather Terflinger and Kelley Meiklejohn each had 12 points for Manchester, hitting 5-10 shots from the floor.

The Spartans fell to host Trinity 77-63 in the opening game of the tournament. Manchester trailed 34-23 at the half, and was down as many as 18 points in the second half. Manchester cut the Trinity lead down to eight, 71-63 with less than a minute remaining, but TU capitalized on 6-6 free throw shooting down the stretch to halt the Spartans comeback attempt.

Stacey Wendel led all scorers with 19 points, hitting 7-13 shots from the floor and 4-6 three pointers. Sarah Bose chipped in 13 points and four rebounds on 5-9 shooting, with three assists and a pair of steals. Heather Terflinger added five points and nine rebounds.

Manchester evens their record at 6-6 on the year. They resume action on Wednesday, Jan. 3 as they host Hanover College to resume HCAC play. Tip-off is scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. start.
