QUAKERS HAND SPARTANS 49-35 LOSS

Earlham College quarterback Justin Rummell threw for 507 yards on 30-39 passing with seven touchdowns as Earlham defeated Manchester 49-35. Rummell broke school records with most yards in a game and tied his touchdown passes in a game record set last year also against Manchester in the game.

Earlham scored on their first possession in the opening quarter, but Manchester bounced back on a Joel Hawkins to Jovan Joyner 58-yard touchdown pass to tie the game at 7-7. Rummell threw for a pair of touchdowns in the second quarter, while MC's Hawkins scored on a seven-yard run to give Earlham a 21-14 lead at the half.

Earlham and Manchester exchanged a pair of touchdowns each in the third, but Earlham went ahead 49-28 with seven minutes in the fourth on Rummell's seventh touchdown strike of the day. MC scored with 4:35 remaining in the game as quarterback Mark Sudhoff broke free for a 31-yard touchdown run, and following place kicker Kevin Phelps' fifth PAT attempt, cut the Earlham lead to 49-35.

Joel Hawkins ended the game 14-28 passing with 284 yards, two interceptions and two touchdown passes. He also ran for two TD's. Jovan Joyner ended the game with three catches for 119 yards and a TD.

Defensively, Josh Alvies had nine tackles and a pair of pass deflections for Manchester. Beau Bradtmiller also had nine tackles, while Zack Smith had eight tackles, a forced fumble and fumble recovery for MC. Manchester falls to 1-1 on the year, and returns to action Thursday night for a special mid-week game at Olivet starting at 7 p.m.



WOMEN 2ND, MEN 3RD AT DEFIANCE INVITE

Manchester's women's cross country team placed second out of eleven schools at the Defiance Invitational on Saturday. Becca Flanders led MC with an eighth place finish in 20:45. Tiffany Alva was 14th in 21:27, Breana Lindsay was 16th in 21:30, Meganmarie Pinkerton was 20th in 21:52 and Ashton Gipson was 22nd in 21:54 to lead the top five for MC.

In the men's division, Manchester placed third out of nine schools, led by Andy Williams' 10th place finish in 28:13. Adam Wolfe was 14th in 28:43, followed by Neil Rodenbeck's 21st place finish in 29:10. Josh Nifong was 23rd in 29:17 and Ryan Spiess was 31st in 29:58. Manchester returns to action Friday at the Indiana Intercollegiate meet hosted by Indiana State University.

BRADTMUELLER NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM AT ROSE INVITE

Manchester College sophomore Lindsey Bradtmueller was named to the All-Tournament team as Manchester finished with a 1-3 record at the Rose-Hulman Invitational.

Manchester opened with a 3-1 win over Wilmington. Bradtmueller had 17 kills and 21 digs to lead Manchester. Amy Carnahan added nine kills and 14 digs.

The Spartans fell to Principia 3-2 and Bradtmueller again led MC with 14 kills. Jane Korzen had 29 kills and Tiffany Moore led the team with 30 assists.

On Saturday Manchester fell to Earlham 3-0, as Bradtmueller had 11 kills and 14 digs, while Tiffany Moore added 27 assists. MC closed out the tournament with a 3-2 loss to Centre. Rebecca Varnes had 10 kills, while teammates Korzen and Bradtmueller added 20 digs each.

Manchester falls to 2-6 on the year. They travel to Grace on Wednesday then return home Friday and Saturday for the Manchester College Invite.

MANCHESTER 3-1 WINNERS OVER MOODY BIBLE

Manchester's men's soccer team picked up a 3-1 win at Moody Bible on Saturday. Brian Woods scored on a Chaz Roots assist in the first half of play to give MC a 1-0 lead at the break. Moody Bible went on to score in the second half to tie the game on an unassisted goal to give MC the 2-1 advantage, and Elie Francois scored the insurance goal in the 79th minute of play to give Manchester the 3-1 win. Kyle Odgen recorded three saves in the win, improving MC's record to 3-1 on the year following a 2-0 loss Wednesday to Albion. They return to action Tuesday at Huntington.

**MARIAN EDGES MC IN OT**

Marian College got the best of MC in action at Marian Saturday, as the Knights defeated Manchester 1-0 in overtime. The women's soccer team posted a 5-2 win over Huntington on Tuesday in other action last week. Melissa Bruns scored her first goal of the season off a Miranda Ford assist. Adding to the Spartan scoring efforts for the day were Alicia Krueckeberg, who had one goal and one assist, Stacey Jerke with a goal and the game winner, and Paige Koomler who had two goals and an assist. The loss drops Manchester to 2-2 on the year. They return to action Wednesday as they open at home for the first time this season against St. Mary's.

WOMEN'S GOLF FOURTH AT ANDERSON INVITE

The MC women's golf team placed fourth out of nine schools at the 2006 Anderson Invitational over the weekend. Manchester missed placing third by one stroke over Marian as Manchester scored a 673 to Marian's 672.

Anita Zollars led MC with a 77-82/159 for a seventh place finish. Jessica Strange fired an 81-83/164, Melissa Heffner shot a 90-80/170, Stacey Goins had a 92-90/182, while Erica Hahn scored a 90-95/185. Manchester returns to action September 23/24 at the Olivet Invite.

SPARTANS MAKE IT 33 STRAIGHT

The MC women's tennis team posted a pair of 9-0 conference victories on Saturday to extend their conference-match win streak to 33 consecutive games, dating back to September of 2002. Manchester swept Transylvania in tennis action in the morning session, then posted a 9-0 win over Franklin in the evening session following Sarah Conwell's 7-6, 3-6, (10-5) tie breaker match to seal the win.
