#### MANCHESTER FALLS TO ROSE 34-3

Manchester wrapped up their home schedule on Saturday with a 34-3 loss to Rose-Hulman (6-4, 3-4 HCAC).

Rose-Hulman scored at the 11:29 mark of the first half as Adam Helmerich recovered a blocked punt into the endzone for a quick 7-0 lead. The Spartans scored on the ensuing drive as Kevin Phelps nailed a 21-yard field goal attempt to pull within four, 7-3.

Rose scored 28 unanswered points with touchdowns at the 4:23 mark of the first quarter as Tim Schrock capitalized on a one-yard scamper and two Jeremy Sharp 30-yard field goals in the second period gave the Engineers a 17-3 lead at the half.

Justin Meade scored on a 28-yard pass from Cameron Hummel with two minutes remaining in the third, and Thomas Reives broke open a 70-yard TD run to seal the 34-3 win to start the fourth quarter.

Statistically for Manchester, Joel Hawkins ended with 96 rushing yards on 16 carries. He was 10-31 passing for 73 yards and two interceptions. Jovan Joyner had four catches for 43 yards and 60 yards rushing on two carries.

Zack Smith ended the game with 13 tackles, and is six tackles shy of reaching the 100 mark. Mike DePoy added seven tackles and Tyler Smith chipped in five.

The Spartans fall to 1-8 on the year, 0-6 in the HCAC. They return to action next Saturday at Anderson for the sixth annual Bronze Ball Trophy game.

#### VOLLEYBALL FALLS TO FRANKLIN IN HCAC TOURNAMENT

Manchester's volleyball season came to a close on Saturday as Manchester fell to Franklin 3-0 in the quarterfinals of the HCAC Conference Championship Tournament. Game scores were 30-26, 30-17, 30-14. Lindsey Bradtmueller led MC with eight kills and 10 digs, and Rebecca Varnes added six kills and a dig.

They picked up a win at home on Wednesday in a 3-1 victory over Goshen, game scores were 30-20, 28-30, 30-25, 30-21. Stephanie Rion led Manchester with 11 kills and 20 digs. Lindsey Bradtmueller added 10 kills and 19 digs. Rebecca Varnes and Tasia Smith added 9 kills a piece and Amy Carnahan had eight kills and 21 digs. Manchester ends the season 11-18 overall and fourth place in the HCAC.

#### PIONEERS END MANCHESTER'S SEASON IN SEMI-FINALS OF HCAC TOURNAMENT

Manchester's women's soccer season came to a close on Tuesday as Transylvania defeated Manchester 2-1 in the semi-finals of the HCAC Conference Tournament. Manchester was the second conference school to score a goal this year against Transy, who took home the league championship with an 8-0 record.

Alicia Krueckeberg scored for Manchester in the 50th minute of play off a Miranda Ford assist to give Manchester the 1-0 lead. Transy bounced back to score in the 55th and 88th minute of play to take the 2-1 win.

Manchester ends the season 11-6-1 on the year.
