SPARTANS FALL TO DEPAUW 68-60 IN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME OF BANKERS' CLASSIC

Manchester's men's team fell to DePauw University 68-60 in the championship game of the Manchester College Bankers' Classic on Saturday. Manchester trailed 33-21 at the half, and MC trailed by just four points, 61-57, with 1:28 left in the game, but DePauw was able to maintain their lead to finish the game for the 68-60 finale.

Jamaal Wade had a game-high 21 points on 7-12 shooting from the floor and 5-7 from the free throw line. He added three rebounds and a blocked shot for the Spartans, while Jeff Grabowski hit 8-0 shots for 18 points with five rebounds. Nathan Ferch was 4-4 from the floor for 10 points with four rebounds.

MC's men's basketball team posted a 79-69 win over Taylor-Fort Wayne on Saturday in the opening round of the 2007 Manchester College Bankers' Classic on Friday. Manchester jumped out to a 15-5 lead in the first five minutes of action, but Taylor-FW cut the Spartan lead to a 24-23 margin with 10 minutes remaining in the first half. MC used a 12-2 run in the next four minutes of play to take a 36-25 lead, and held a 47-32 margin at the half.

The Spartans were able to maintain a near double digit lead throughout the second half to pick up the 79-69 win. Wade led the Spartans with 19 points on 5-9 shooting and 6-6 from the free throw line. Grabowski was 5-7 from the floor for 12 points. He added six rebounds in the win, while Logan Smith scored nine points. Jake Koziel added eight points and five assists and Nathan Ferch added eight points in the win.

Both Wade and Grabowski were named to the All-Tournament team, along with Taylor-Fort Wayne's Montrel Hogue, Illinois Tech's Rob Knapczyk and DePauw's Brian Oilar and Tournament MVP Ryan Werntz.

The men drop to 1-1 on the year, and travel to Tri-State on Tuesday for a doubleheader with the women's team.

MANCHESTER FALLS TO CAPITAL IN SEASON OPENER, SCORES 106 AGAINST DOMINICAN IN CONSOLATION GAME

Manchester's women's basketball picked up a 106-73 win over Dominican in the consolation game of the 2007 Manchester College Bankers' Classic. Jessica Henn led the way with 20 points, hitting 8-10 shots from the floor and 4-5 free throws. Kelley Meiklejohn added 16 points on 6-8 shooting, with five rebounds. Kristen Lancaster was 6-12 from the floor for 13 points, while Lauren Kalis and Toni Hayward added 10 points each.

The Spartans fell to Capital in Friday's opening game 71-57. The Crusaders held a 41-29 lead at the half after taking a 12-2 advantage to start the game and were up by as many as 13 in the first half as they held a 26-13 lead with less than 10 minutes remaining. Manchester went on a 14-5 run to cut the Capital lead to a 31-27 margin with three minutes, but Capital used a 10-2 spurt to close out the half.

Kelley Meiklejohn had 19 points to lead all scorers in the game. She added seven rebounds and a blocked shot for the Spartans. Sarah Bose added 18 points while Rachel Wilkinson added 13 points for MC.

Manchester, currently 1-1 on the year travels to Tri-State on Tuesday.
