MANCHESTER FALLS TO TRANSYLVANIA 79-61

Manchester's men's basketball fell to host Transylvania 79-61 in action Saturday afternoon. Transylvania connected on 17 three-pointers to assist in the win.

Jamaal Wade led Manchester with 16 points, hitting 6-11 shots from the floor. He added two blocks and four steals for MC. Jake Koziel added 10 points on 4-4 shooting, while Nathan Ferch and Logan Smith added eight points each.

Manchester, 3-5 overall, 1-1 in the HCAC, returns to action Tuesday, December 18th as they travel to Franklin and Marshall for a 7 p.m. contest.

SPARTANS GET FIRST HCAC WIN IN AN 87-85 VICTORY OVER MOUNT ST. JOSEPH

The MC men's basketball team picked up an 87-85 win over Mount St. Joseph on Saturday for their first conference win of the season. The Spartans trailed 28-14 midway through the first half, but went on a 21-5 run to take a one point lead with two minutes remaining, but the Mount rebounded and held a 40-37 advantage at the break.

In the second half, Manchester hit 22-25 free throws to outscore the Lions 50-45 for the 87-85 win. Jeff Grabowski led MC with an 8-13 performance from the floor and had 20 points. Senior Jake Koziel was 5-7 from the field and 9-10 at the free throw line for a total of 19 points to go with his five rebounds. Jamaal Wade added 14 points with three steals while Lorenzo Griffin scored eight straight points to give the Spartans a three point lead with 3:36 remaining, and ended the game with 12 points overall.

MANCHESTER POSTS 63-55 WIN OVER TRANSYLVANIA

Manchester's women's basketball team posted a 63-55 win over Transylvania on Saturday to extend their conference season winning streak to 17 games. Manchester took a 26-24 into the half, and used 20-23 shooting at the free throw line in the second half to aid in the 63-55 victory.

Kelley Meiklejohn and Rachel Wilkinson led all scorers with 17 points each. Sarah Conwell and Jessica Henn added eight points each as Manchester improves to 5-2 on the year, 2-0 in the HCAC. The Spartans return to action Sunday, December 16 as they travel to Carthage.

MC PICKS UP 59-55 WIN OVER MOUNT ST. JOSEPH

Manchester's women's basketball team picked up a 59-55 win over Mount St. Joseph to start the HCAC conference season. The Spartans extend it's conference win-streak to 16 games after winning 15-straight last season.

Manchester held a 24-18 lead at the half, holding the Lions to 26 percent shooting on 7-27 shots. The Lions bounced back in the second half, connecting on 60 percent of their field goals. MSJ took a 37-36 lead with 10:50 to go in the game, but MC went on a 12-2 run to take a nine-point lead three minutes later, 48-39.

Kelley Meiklejohn led all scorers with 14 points. Rachel Wilkinson added 10 points for MC, while Jessica Henn added eight points and six rebounds.

Manchester opened up with a pair of wins from Eracleo Vallejo, as he pinned Levi Mundy in 4:45 at 125 points, and John Sheets, as he was a 5-4 winner over Josh Billau at 133 pounds. Joel Sherer picked up a win by pin in 4:08 over Ryan Lineberry at 165 pounds and Rob Osborne was a 3-0 winner over alex Fleet at 197.

Manchester got wins in the exhibition matches from Austen Ruich at 133, Matt Joyce at 157 and Tyler Lathon at 197.
