MC MOVES TO 3-0 IN CONFERENCE PLAY FOLLOWING 70-59 WIN OVER FRANKLIN

Manchester's women's basketball team posted a 70-59 road win over Franklin Saturday to improve to 3-0 in conference play.

Manchester and Franklin went into the half with a 36-36 tie, and the Spartans held FC to 26 percent field goal shooting in the second half to take the 70-59 win.

Kelley Meiklejohn led MC with 16 points, connecting on 7-13 shots from the floor and had nine rebounds and three blocked shots on the day. Kristen Lancaster added 13 points on 6-6 shooting from the field and added two steals defensively. Rachel Wilkinson and Jessica Henn added nine points each while Sarah Bose had eight rebounds to go with her seven points, five steals and five assist performance.

Manchester improves to 8-4 overall, 3-0 in the HCAC. They host Bluffton on Wednesday night.

FRANKLIN DOWNS MC 74-60

Franklin College picked up their first conference win of the year as the Spartans fell to the Grizzlies 74-60.

Franklin took a 38-27 lead into the half, and used 65 percent field goal shooting in the second half to pick the 74-60 win.

Jeff Grabowski led all scorers with 18 points, hitting 5-8 shots from the field and 6-7 free throw attempts. He added six rebounds on the day for the Spartans. Jamaal Wade added 14 points with four rebounds and a steal. James reed went 4-4 from the floor for 10 points.

Manchester fell to Elmhurst College 76-62 in road action Wednesday. Elmhurst is currently ranked 14th in the d3hoops.com national polls. MC trailed by eight points in the first half as Elmhurst took a 38-30 lead into the break. MC was outscored 38-32 in the second half in route to the 76-62 loss.

Jamaal Wade led all scorers with 18 points on the evening. He was 4-9 from the field and 8-10 at the free throw line. Mitch Schaefer added 11 points on 5-7 shooting from the field, with three rebounds and a steal.

The Spartans fall to 3-9 overall, 1-2 in the HCAC. They return to action Wednesday at Bluffton.

Joel Sherer ended the tournament 1-2 overall at 165 after falling in the opening match of the day, but won his second match in the consolation brackets before being eliminated.
