SPARTANS EDGED BY ROSE-HULMAN 64-57

The men's basketball team fell to Rose-Hulman 64-57 in home conference action on Saturday. Manchester shot 8-23 in the first half and trailed 29-23 at the break. Manchester tied the game at 44-44 with under seven minutes to go in the game, but Rose-Hulman connected on 12 of 15 free throws down the stretch to pick up the 64-57 win.

Jamaal Wade led all scorers with 23 points, hitting 8-13 shots from the floor. Nathan Ferch added 10 points and seven rebounds, hit all three field goal attempts and went 4-5 at the free throw line.

The men's team fell to Bluffton 80-67 on Wednesday. Bluffton held a 48-31 lead at the break, hitting 7-9 three point attempts and 58 percent of their field goal attempts. Manchester hit 6-11 three-pointers in the second half and outscored BU 36-32, but it wasn't enough as Bluffton pulled off the 80-67 win.

First year player Mitch Schaefer hit 6-10 three pointers and led all spartans with 18 points. Jerry Ford connected on 4-6 field goals and 3-5 free throws for 11 points. Logan Smith added nine points for MC.

Manchester falls to 3-11 on the year, 1-4 in the HCAC. They travel to Anderson on Wednesday.

HENN SCORES 15 AS MANCHESTER DEFEATS ROSE-HULMAN 57-45

Manchester's women's basketball team posted their 20th straight conference win Saturday following a 57-45 road win. MC held a 21-12 lead at the half, limiting Rose-Hulman to 5-21 shooting from the field, yet connected on 6-20 shots themselves. The Spartans regrouped in the second half to shoot 12-22 from the field in route to the 57-45 win.

Jessica Henn led Manchester with 15 points, shooting 4-5 from the floor and 7-8 at the free throw line. She added six rebounds in the win. Kelley Meiklejohn added 13 points and three rebounds with a pair of steals. Lauren Kalis chipped in seven points and five rebounds for the Spartans.

On Wednesday, the Spartans defeated Bluffton 61-58. Manchester held a three point lead at the half 29-26, but Bluffton rallied to take an eight point lead, 47-39 with 11 minutes remaining in the contest. Manchester went on a 13-2 run over the next six minutes of action to take a three point lead with five minutes to go in the contest.

Sarah Conwell led Manchester with 14 points, hitting 5-8 shots from the floor, 3-5 three point attempts and had six rebounds. Kailey Honn went 4-5 from the field and 4-4 from the free throw line for 12 points. She added six blocked shots and three rebounds.

Manchester moves to 10-4 overall, 5-0 in the HCAC. They host Anderson on Wednesday.

VALLEJO WINS AT NORTH CENTRAL INVITE, SPARTANS PLACE 9th OVERALL

Manchester College took ninth place out of 16 teams at the North Central Invitational over the weekend.

125 pounder Eracleo Vallejo took first place with a 4-0 record in the two-day tournament. He defeated Joe Norton of North Central 5-4 in the championship match. Vallejo is currently 17-2 on the year and ranked 2nd in the nation in the latest NCAA Division III polls. Nate Hodges took sixth place at 184 pounds and was the only other place winner for MC.

Manchester returns to action this coming Saturday as they host the annual Spartan Mat Classic starting at 9 a.m.

MC COMPETES AT HUNTINGTON INDOOR MEET

Manchester College's indoor track and field season began Saturday as Manchester took part in the Huntington University Indoor Frozen Forest Invitational.

Winners in the women's events were Jessi Bremer in the 800 meter (2:30), Becca Flanders in the 1600 meter (5:36) and Lindsey Machamer in the shot put (35'8") and weight throw (34'3").

In the men's events, winners for MC were Jermiah Jones in the 55 meter (6.6), Korey Bucher in the 400 meter (52.9), Andy Williams in the 1600 meter (4:39), Rick Morgan in the 55 meter hurdles (9.19), Tyler Hufnagle in the high jump (5'10"), Beau Bradtmiller in the pole vault (15'0") and Brandon Dyben in both the shot put (38'10") and the weight throw (44'11").

The Spartans return to action Saturday, January 19th at the Wabash Indoor Meet.
