SPARTANS PICK UP 20-7 WIN OVER DEFIANCE FOR FIRST HCAC WIN

Brandon Wells rushed for a one-yard TD while quarterback Caleb Grimes found Jordan Cork on a 29-yard TD pass and Jared Yoder on a 14-yard score in the first half to give Manchester a 20-7 win over Defiance in HCAC action.

Wells rushed for 158 of Manchester's 209 yards on the afternoon. Wells had 34 carries and a touchdown for the Spartans and added 35 yards on five receptions. Grimes finished the afternoon 19-31 passing with two interceptions and 152 yards passing with two touchdowns. Jordan Cork had 48 yards receiving while Jared Yoder added 45 yards on four catches each.

Mike DePoy led the way defensively with eight tackles and a forced fumble. Jemiah Jones added six tackles while Beau Bradtmiller, Ben Rogowski and Beau Fulk each recovered fumbles for MC.

Manchester improves to 3-2 on the year, 1-1 in the HCAC. They travel to Bluffton on Saturday for a 1:30 p.m. start.

ROWE SCORES TWO GOALS IN 2-0 WIN OVER HOLY CROSS COLLEGE

Manchester College senior Chris Rowe scored both goals in Manchester's 2-0 win over Holy Cross College - Notre Dame on Saturday's Homecoming game. Rowe scored in the 4th minute of action and again in the 34th minute of play on a Dylan Bush assist for the 2-0 win. Goalkeep Matt Mullen had seven saves in the shutout win.

The Spartan men's soccer team posted a 3-2 win over Anderson, marking their second conference win of the year. Manchester took a 2-0 lead into the half as Ben Cole scored unassisted and Heriju Gadzama scored on a Cole assist. The Ravens scored nine minutes into the second half, but Manchester responded with a Chris Rowe goal on a Gadzama assist to take a 3-1 lead. Anderson scored in the 68th minute to pull within one, 3-2, but Manchester's defense held AU scoreless for the remaining 22 minutes of play to pick up the win.

Manchester, winners in their third straight match, improve to 5-8-2 on the year and return to action Saturday at Mount St. Joseph.

MANCHESTER WINS SECOND STRAIGHT IN 7-0 WIN OVER ST. MARY OF THE WOODS

Manchester's women's soccer team posted a 7-0 win against St. Mary of the Woods in the tail end of a double-header with the men's soccer team on Homecoming.

Manchester got the game winner from Kendra Getz, who had one goal and one assist. Paige Koomler added three goals and an assist, Stephanie Phillips, Kali Lauzon and Jenny Smith also had goals for Manchester. Erica Hedges added three saves in the shutout win.

Manchester improves to 5-7 on the year, and returns to non-conference action Wednesday as they host Alma for a 4 p.m. contest.

FIVE SPARTANS WIN INDIVIDUAL FLIGHT TITLES AT HCAC INVITE

Manchester College's women's tennis team had five individual flight winners at the HCAC Flighted Invite over the weekend.

Christa Hunter defeated Kayli Schafer of Franklin 5-7, 7-6 (7-0), 6-4 to capture the three singles championship. Brittany Oliver posted a 6-1, 6-1 win over Franklin's Christy Tucker to win at five singles while Danielle Walker was a 7-6 (7-2), 6-3 winner over Klara Schroederus of Rose-Hulman to win at six singles.

Hunter and Walker teamed up to post an 8-5 win over Hanover to win the two doubles flight and it was April Erxleben and Nikki Ferguson posting an 8-5 win at three doubles, also against Hanover.

Manchester returns to action Thursday as they face Rose-Hulman in a tie-breaker match for the fourth and final spot in Friday's HCAC Automatic Qualifier Tournament hosted at the West Indy Racquet Club.

MANCHESTER FINISHES SECOND AT HCAC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Manchester's women's golf team posted a second place finish at the HCAC Conference Championships, hosted by Rose-Hulman. Manchester ended the first round of action with a third place team score of 368, and fired a 359 in the second round to overtake Hanover in the team standings.

Stacey Goins shot an 88-84/172 to place fourth overall to lead Manchester. Erica Hahn fired an 83-96/179 to place eighth in the individual standings. Both earned All-Conference honors. Mary Verduce placed 11th with a 99-87/186 and Chelsea Johnson shot a 98-92/190 to tie for 16th place.
