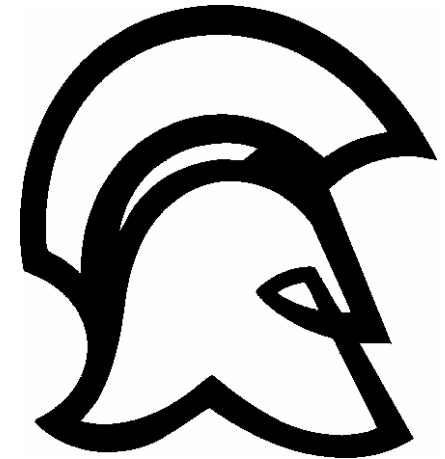

## **About the Coaches**

**Brad Nadborne** is in his fourth season as Head Men's Basketball Coach at Manchester College. In his first two years at Manchester, Nadborne's basketball teams have finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference. Prior to coaching at Manchester College, Nadborne coached at the University of Wisconsin – La Crosse, DePauw University, Cornell University, and the University of Colorado. Highlights of Nadborne's coaching career have been being a part of the DePauw team that made it to the NCAA Elite Eight; being a part of three teams that traveled to Europe to play basketball internationally; and , having coached players who have gone on to play in the National Basketball Association (NBA), as well as various professional leagues in Europe. Nadborne played college basketball at DePauw University, after playing his freshman season at Army under current Duke University coach Mike Krzyzewski.

**Eric Dougal** starts his second season as the Assistant Basketball Coach at Manchester College. Eric comes to Manchester after spending one season as an assistant coach at Craig High School, in his hometown of Janesville, Wisconsin. Prior to that, Eric was an undergraduate at the University of Wisconsin – La Crosse, where he majored in Physical Education, and also played guard on the basketball team. In the 2002-2003 season, while playing for Coach Nadborne, Eric led the team in three point field goal percentage, shooting 43%. Eric's enthusiasm for basketball, outstanding people skills, and tremendous knowledge of the game of basketball have already made him a great fit for the Manchester College Basketball Program.
