Volunteer at the Fort Wayne Children's Zoo!

Volunteer for our Wild Zoo Halloween event! The ten dates for the 2015 event are: October 22-25 and 29-31. Guests can enter the Zoo from 12:00-5:00 PM daily, and are welcome to enjoy the Zoo until 6:00 PM. We staff in shifts for this event - either 11:30-3:15 PM or 2:45-6:15 PM (or all day if you're willing!). Timely arrival is crucial, as we meet together for assignments and instructions and then must get all 40 volunteers into position before the event starts. We ask volunteers to make sure to serve the entire shift - it takes a fully staffed crew to ensure the event runs smoothly for our guests. Volunteers must be at least 13 years old, and we encourage them to dress in family friendly costumes (merry not scary!), and no full face masks please! We typically staff 2 people per station. We have 10 treat stations, and several more interactive and game stations.

Most help needed during weekdays.

This is a rain or shine event, so volunteers should dress for the weather (including cold and rain)! Volunteers park in the gravel lot across the street from the Zoo, and enter through our service entrance at the corner of Franke Park Drive and Sherman Boulevard (by the 3-way stop signs). Veer to the right, go through the wooden gates and you'll come out inside the Zoo by Croaky the Frog and the lynx exhibit. The first ramp to your right, up the hill, leads to the Discovery Classroom where all volunteers will check in, receive their assigned positions, and instructions for the day. If you would like to participate, please let me know names, numbers of volunteers and which dates and shift times you're
