### **Did You Know? Birth Control Edition**

- Birth Control provides benefits beyond preventing pregnancy.
- ✓ Some of these benefits include protection against acne, cramping, heavy periods, irregular periods, PMS, bone thinning, ovarian cancer.
- ✔ Birth control also has different risks depending on the type of hormone.
- Some birth control pills contain two hormones: estrogen and progestin. These are called combination pills.
- Combination pills work by keeping eggs from leaving the ovaries and thickening the cervical mucus to prevent sperm from even reaching the eggs.
