GIJSBERT AND ROBBYN van Frankenhuyzen have lived on their 40-acre farm in Bath, Mich., since 1980. From what began as a sheep farm, with corn, soy and hayfields, they eventually created a wildlife refuge. As stewards of this small piece of land, the van Frankenhuyzens dug ponds, planted thousands of trees, and created natural prairies.

During their 25 years of wildlife rehabilitation, this unique property became a safe haven for many of the orphaned and injured wild animals that they nurtured back to health. Teaming up to write and illustrate children's books, Robbyn and Gijsbert share their love for nature in their art and their words. They visit schools, zoos, and nature centers sharing with children and adults the value of journaling, the joy of drawing and the importance of protecting our natural world.

The van Frankenhuyzens will present writing and illustration workshops at Manchester Elementary School on Sept. 25–26, in collaboration with Manchester University Galleries. A reception open to the public will be held in Cordier Auditorium Lobby Gallery on Sept. 27, from 5 to 7 p.m.
