

**CALL FOR ENTRIES:  
HOMECOMING: THE ALUMNI SHOW**

**Description**

This juried invitational exhibition features artists who majored/minored in art at Manchester (College) University. (*We also welcome any alumni who became artists after their time at Manchester!*) Alumni artists are encouraged to submit up to three works for consideration. Works must be original and completed after the artist's year of graduation. There are no size restrictions (2D and 3D works are appropriate), however gallery space is limited.

**To Enter your Work**

Email (1) JPEG attachment @ 72dpi and less than 1MB, labeled with your full name to [eroke@manchester.edu](mailto:eroke@manchester.edu). Please include your name, title of the work, year of creation, medium/technique, and dimensions in the body of the email. Artists may submit up to three entries. Artists submitting multiple entries must send multiple separate emails. Incomplete or incorrectly formatted entries will not be considered. All works selected must be suitably prepared for display/hanging, including any specialized hardware or equipment required. Accepted artists will be notified by email with details and instructions for the delivery of works.

**Entry Fees**

There are no entry fees for this exhibition; however, artists are responsible for shipping/ mailing costs incurred in the delivery and pick up of artworks.

**Deadlines**

- Submission deadline via email: 4:00 p.m., Friday, August 2, 2019
- Notification of acceptance via email: Monday, August 9, 2019
- Delivery of works: Works mailed/shipped in may be sent in any time before August 30, 2019. To deliver works in person, call 260-982-5334 to make arrangements. *All* works must be received before August 30.
- Exhibition dates: September 20 to November 15, 2019
- Alumni welcoming reception: 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday, October 12, 2019 (Homecoming weekend)
- Pick up of works: By special arrangement.

**Sales**

Works need not be for sale to enter. Parties interested in purchasing artworks are encouraged to contact the artists directly. Link Gallery does not facilitate commissioned sales. All works should have a monetary value noted for insurance purposes.

Accepted works must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.
