Current projects offer training in organic synthesis of new drug candidates, mammalian cell culture, genotyping, investigation of mechanism of action of anti-cancer compounds, and other contemporary molecular biological and biochemical techniques. Students will be expected to work 20 hours per week and will receive a stipend. No student housing will be available in Fort Wayne.
