CHEMISTRY PLACEMENT EXAM

Students intending to study any of these areas – biology, chemistry, biology-chemistry, environmental studies, exercise science, athletic training, medical technology, nursing or pre-pharmacy are required to take this placement exam. There are three parts of 20 questions each: 1) general mathematics, 2) general chemical information, 3) specific chemical knowledge.

ENGLISH PLACEMENT WRITING SUBMISSION

Select students must submit an English writing sample. Students required to do so will be provided information by the Office of Admissions. The writing sample will be used in conjunction with high school records to determine the course that best meets academic needs and background.

MUSIC THEORY PLACEMENT EXAM

Students interested in either a music major or music minor must take the Music Theory placement exam. The exam is for placement purposes only and will not affect admission to the Music Department or scholarship awards. This test is intended to help determine whether students will need to take the Music Fundamentals course during their first semester at Manchester.

SPANISH PLACEMENT EXAM

Students who have taken Spanish in high school and are interested in taking Spanish courses in college must take this placement exam.
