Naplex Pass Rates

NABP released the NAPLEX pass rates for the class of 2025 in late January. The first-time pass rate increased both here at Manchester and nationally as compared to the class of 2024.

Manchester pass rates are within the standards set by our accreditor, ACPE, however, we are looking at possible ways to continue to increase our first-time pass rates for our students. Your precepting is an important part of this and we appreciate all you do for Manchester students.


