

## **Manchester University Study Away Scholarships**

There is a single application for Manchester University donor-supported Study Away Scholarships. The application is sent to all enrolled undergraduate students during the month of February. Once awarded, these scholarships can be disbursed beginning on July 1<sup>st</sup> of the same calendar year (i.e. new fiscal year). The scholarships can be applied as a payment directly to a January Travel Course account (through the Office of Financial Services) or requested to be disbursed directly to the student recipient if being used for a semester Study Away program.

The purpose of these scholarships is to increase opportunities for MU undergraduate students to study internationally or in other programs in the United States. All continuing undergraduate MU students are eligible to apply during this annual award cycle for the upcoming academic year. Awards normally range from \$500-1500 and are in addition to and beyond the usual student aid and normal finances of the student. Coordinated by the Office of Study Away, with Office of Academic Affairs support, we are immensely grateful for the support of our generous donors.

### **Kauffman Award**

In honor of the memory of Manchester University graduate Bruce Kauffman, who was a scholar, musician, and financier, a generous benefactor and Bruce's college roommate, established an endowment fund for Manchester University students who choose to study away, either internationally or in an approved program in the U.S., during their undergraduate years. The fund makes off-campus study possible for students who are unable to pursue coursework of this nature due to financial constraints. This award is particularly relevant for students who have dreamed of studying abroad, or of participating in an off-campus program in the U.S., but who did not believe it would be possible to do so. All Manchester University undergraduate students are eligible, with preference given to provide financial support for strong academic students in the humanities.

### **Miller Study Abroad Scholarship**

Because of their interest in international cultures, Ed and Martha Miller established this scholarship to aid students who desire to study and learn abroad. Any Manchester University undergraduate student enrolled full-time who plans to study abroad for a year, semester, or January Session is eligible, with preference given to students majoring in the natural and health sciences.

**Dillon Roush and Macon Dale Traxler Scholarship**

This fund was established by the family and friends of Dillon Roush and Macon Dale Traxler. Additional contributions were made by Manchester College alumni who have studied abroad. Income from this fund provides awards to students of above-average academic ability, who have financial need, who are involved in foreign study and who are majors or minors studying in the Modern Languages Department.

**One Campus, Many Cultures Scholarship**

This fund will enable students who would not otherwise be able to have the experience of foreign travel and/or international study to take advantage of such opportunities. Awards will be made on the basis of need and with consideration of how the proposed travel/study opportunity will benefit the recipient's goals.

**Marvin R. and Lois Fike Sherman Scholarship**

International students currently attending Manchester University and are interested in studying away (domestically or internationally), will be given first preference for this scholarship. Should no International student(s) be available, second preference would be for any student of need studying away.

**Professor Gary A. Zimmerman Cultural Psychology Travel Scholarship**

This scholarship is established in loving tribute to Professor Emeriti Gary Zimmerman '64, because of his love of travel and passion for experiential education. Preference shall be given to psychology majors or minors traveling to Hawaii for the cross cultural psychology January term course or other psychology off campus course.

**Manchester University Study Away Award**

Through the growing generosity of additional donors, many of whom are Manchester alumni and former study away students themselves with experiences ranging from January Sessions to full academic year study abroad programs, this additional funding is available for all types of study away. Open to all undergraduate students in all academic programs, these funds are provided to ease financial burdens of off-campus study both internationally and in the U.S., and to increase study away opportunities for Manchester University students.

**Allen C. Deeter Study Away Scholarship**

This scholarship is intended to enable students undertaking a cross-cultural study away experience in an approved program who would otherwise find such attendance financially impossible or extremely difficult. The order of preference for the awarding of this

scholarship is as follows: Year-long international study away programs, international study away programs that require mastery of a language other than English, cross-cultural internships, short term off campus travel courses, or short-term language immersion and cross-cultural programs.
